# Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

### Introduction

**HLTAID001** Provid ecardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is for both new learners and those refreshing their existing skills. It is recommended that Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is updated every 12 months.

This short course is specifically designed to provide students with the knowledge to perform CPR in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines. Areas covered include introduction to first aid principles, airway and breathing management and cardiopulmonary resuscitation and defibrillation. Students will be required to demonstrate that they have the required knowledge and skills necessary to manage an unconscious, non-breathing casualty to the arrival of medical aid.

### Pre-Requisites / Entry Requirements

- There are no qualification pre-requisites for this course
- Learners must be aged 16 years or older
- Photo Identification is required to be sited prior to course commencement
- Language, literacy and numeracy skills
- Learners must be physically capable of bending and kneeling to provide first aid to a person on the floor. This includes performing CPR for up to 5 minutes.
- Completed enrolment form
- Payment of the course cost

### Mode of Delivery

Delivery of this course will be trainer led, face to face in a classroom setting combined with skills practice assessment.
